

#### Mother's Day History

Celebrations of mothers can be traced back to the ancient Greeks and Romans, who held festivals in honor of the mother goddesses, but the clearest modern precedent for Mother's Day is the early Christian festival known as "Mothering Sunday." Over time the Mothering Sunday tradition shifted into a more secular holiday, and children would present their mothers with flowers and other tokens of appreciation. The Origins of Mother's Day as celebrated in the United States date back to the 19th century. Ann Reeves Jarvis helped start "Mother's Day Work Clubs" to teach local women how to properly care for their children. These clubs later became a unifying force in a region of the country divided over the Civil War. In 1868 Jarvis organized "mother's Friendship Day," at which mothers gathered with former Union and Confederate soldiers to promote reconciliation. The official Mother's Day holiday arose in the 1900s as a result of the efforts of Anna Jarvis, daughter of Ann Reeves Jarvis. Following her mother's 1905 death, Anna Jarvis conceived of Mother's Day as a way of honoring the sacrifices mothers made for their children. In May 1908 she organized the first official Mother's Day celebration at a church in West Virginia. Next, Jarvis resolved to see her holiday added to the national calendar. Arguing that American holidays were biased toward male achievements, she started a massive letter writing campaign to newspapers and prominent politicians urging the adoption of a special day honoring motherhood. Her persistence paid off in 1914 when president Woodrow Wilson signed a measure officially establishing the second Sunday in May as Mother's Day. In the United States, Mother's Day continues to be celebrated by presenting mothers and other women with gifts and flowers, and it has become one of the biggest holidays for consumer spending. - History.com
