The Science of Sunsets



The third week in July is Capture the Sunset Week, a week to appreciate the gorgeous hues of the setting sun. The colors of a sunset are the result of a process called scattering. Particles in the atmosphere alter the

direction of sunlight. When the sun is low on the horizon, such as at sunset, light has farther to travel and more opportunities to scatter.

Sometimes, short-wavelength light that produces blue or violet colors is so scattered that it is lost altogether, leaving only warmer light colors such as brilliant reds and oranges. These are the dramatic colors we love in a sunset. Pollution can scatter the entire spectrum of light, causing colors to be dull. Clean air is the best ingredient for beautiful sunsets.
